Emergency Called City Council Meeting

The Live Oak City Council met Thursday, March 19, 2020, at 4:30 p.m. in City Hall located at 101 SE White Ave., Live Oak, Florida 32064. The following officials were present: Mayor Frank Davis, Councilmember Robintina Reed, Councilmember David Burch, Council President Mark Stewart, Councilmember Don Allen, Councilmember Bennie Thomas, City Clerk John Gill, and Attorney Fred Koberlein Jr. Absent was: City Manager Ron Williams,

Council President Stewart called the meeting to order.

Council President Stewart proceeded to the first item on the agenda, discussion regarding Resolution No. 2020-06, a resolution finding and declaring the existence of an emergency, as of March 9, 2020, arising from the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-06**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIVE OAK, FLORIDA,  
FINDING AND DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF AN EMERGENCY, AS OF  
MARCH 9, 2020, ARISING FROM THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.

Councilmember Burch moved to approve Resolution No. 2020-06, which Councilmember Allen seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Allen asked if the City has or needs supplies to help with the outbreak of this virus. Finance Director Joann Luther came forward and stated that the City is researching purchasing an automatic sprayer for sanitizer which will be used not only during this state of emergency but can be used all the time. Along with suits for the City Fire Dept. if the needs arise and the suits can also be used for other reasons as well.

Mayor Davis asked Sharon Hingson with the Emergency Management Center of Suwannee County to come forward and update the Council concerning the COVID-19 and the affect this virus is having on the City of Live Oak.

Council President Stewart proceeded to the next item on the agenda, cancelation of the April 14, 2020 regularly scheduled City Council Meeting. Councilmember Burch moved to approve the cancelation of the April 14, 2020 regularly scheduled City Council Meeting, which Councilmember Reed seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Public Comments: Charles Maloy with concerns as to when the next Council meeting will be scheduled.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
