

City of Live Oak  
Special Called City Council Meeting  
September 29, 2020

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The Live Oak City Council met Tuesday, September 29, 2020, at 5:30 p.m. in City Hall located at 101 SE White Ave., Live Oak, Florida 32064. The following officials were present: Mayor Frank Davis, Councilmember David Burch, Council President Mark Stewart, Councilmember Don Allen, Councilmember Lynda Owens, City Manager Ron Williams, City Clerk John Gill, and Attorney Fred Koberlein Jr. Absent: Councilmember Robintina Reed

Council President Stewart called the meeting to order.

Mr. George Curtis led the invocation, which was followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Council President Stewart proceeded with the first item on the agenda, **Final** reading of Ordinance 1455, an Ordinance adopting the City of Live Oak FY 2020-2021 Millage Rate. Council President Stewart requested Mr. Gill to read the Ordinance into the record.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1455**

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND PRESCRIBING THE MILLAGE TO BE  
LEVIED BY THE CITY OF LIVE OAK FLORIDA, FOR THE MUNICIPAL  
PURPOSE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021.

Councilmember Burch moved to approve Ordinance No. 1455, which Councilmember Allen Seconded.

Council President Stewart opened the floor for Public Comments: **No Comments heard.**

Council President Stewart asked for any Council discussion: **None heard.**

Council President Stewart then requested Mr. Gill to perform a roll call vote: Councilmember Reed: Absent, Councilmember Owens: Yes, Councilmember Burch: Yes, Councilmember Stewart: Yes, and Councilmember Allen: Yes. The motion carried unanimously.

Council President Stewart then proceeded to the next item on the agenda, **Final** reading of Ordinance 1456, an Ordinance adopting the City of Live Oak FY 2020-2021 Budget. Council President Stewart requested Mr. Gill to read the Ordinance into the record.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1456**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF LIVE OAK, FLORIDA  
OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021.

Councilmember Allen moved to approve Ordinance No. 1456, which Councilmember Burch seconded.

Council President Stewart opened the floor for Public Comments: **No Comments.**

Council President Stewart asked for any Council discussion: Councilmember Owens requested that the 2% merit raise be given all at once instead of the anniversary date. Also, suggested a 1% COLO and a 1% anniversary date. Mr. Williams stated that this was an administration action.

Council President Stewart then requested Mr. Gill to perform a roll call vote: Councilmember Reed: Absent, Councilmember Owens: No, Councilmember Burch: Yes, Councilmember Stewart: Yes, and Councilmember Allen: Yes. The motion carried 3 to 1.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
