Emergency Called City Council Meeting  
October 25, 2019

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The Live Oak City Council met Friday, October 25, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. in City Hall located at 101 SE White Ave., Live Oak, Florida 32064. The following officials were present: Mayor Frank Davis, Councilmember Robintina Reed, Councilmember David Burch, Council President Mark Stewart, Councilmember Don Allen, City Attorney Fred Koberlein Jr., City Manager Ron Williams, and City Clerk John Gill. Absent Councilmember Bennie Thomas

Council President Stewart called the meeting to order.

Council President Stewart at this time turned the floor over to Mr. Ron Williams, City Manager.

Mr. Williams explained, that the City is required by contract to give Jacobs 120-day notification if the City does not wish to automatically renew the 5- year contract. In order to be within that 120- day margin, the City will need to send a letter out on Friday October 25,2019. Mr. Williams stated that a letter was prepared by Attorney Mr. Fred Koberlein Sr. on behalf of the City and Councilmembers.

Councilmember Burch moved to approve the release of the letter notifying Jacobs that the City would not automatically renew the 5-year contract, which Councilmember Allen seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Council President Stewart at this time asked if there were any comments from the Public, which there were none.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
