Emergency Called City Council Meeting Minutes  
March 12, 2026

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The Live Oak City Council met Thursday, March 12, 2026, at 3:00 p.m. in City Hall located at 101 SE White Ave., Live Oak, Florida 32064 for an Emergency Called City Council Meeting. The following officials were present: Council President Matt Campbell, Councilmember Tommy Jefferson, Councilmember Vanessa Robinson, Councilmember Gladys Owens, Councilmember David Alford, Deputy City Clerk April Marshall, & City Manager Larry Sessions. City Attorney Todd Kennon via telephone. Absent: City Clerk John Gill,

Council President Campbell called the meeting to order.

Councilmember Jefferson led the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Council President Campbell proceeded to discussion with possible council action, Resolution 2026-10, a resolution of the City Council for the City of Live Oak authorizing the submission of the application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Grant Program on behalf of the city of Live Oak, Florida and providing for an effective date. City Manager Session read the title into the record. Councilmember Jefferson made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-10, which Councilmember Robinson seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Council President Campbell proceeded to discussion with possible council action, award bid for RFP 03-2026 design and build for Heritage Park & Gardens and RFP 04-2026 the purchase and installation of two standby natural gas generators. Councilmember Robinson made motion to table both RFP's until the next City Council meeting to allow the agenda items discussed in a public setting, which Councilmember Jefferson seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
