This notice does not constitute consent by the City for the introduction or admission into evidence of otherwise inadmissible or irrelevant evidence, nor does it authorize challenges or appeals not otherwise allowed by law. The City will not provide verbatim minutes; this responsibility would fall to the person appealing the decision.
