Special Called City Council Meeting Minutes
May 26, 2026

The Live Oak City Council met Tuesday, May 26, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. in City Hall located at 101 SE White Ave., Live Oak, Florida 32064 for a Special Called City Council Meeting. The following officials were present: Council President Matt Campbell, Councilmember Gladys Owens, Councilmember David Alford, Mayor Frank Davis, City Clerk John Gill, City Manager Larry Sessions, and City Attorney Todd Kennon. Absent: Councilmember Vanessa Robinson, and Councilmember Tommie Jefferson.

Council President Campbell called the meeting to order.

Mayor Davis led the Invocation followed by Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Council President Campbell proceeded with the approval of the agenda with any additions, deletions or changes. Councilmember Alford made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, which Councilmember Owens second. The motion carried unanimously.

Council President Campbell opened the floor for public comments, with none heard. Council President Campbell closed the floor for public comments.

Council President Campbell proceeded to discussion with council action, interlocal agreement renewal between Suwannee County, City of Live Oak, and the Town of Branford, providing for a distribution formula for local option gas tax. City Attorney Kennon explained the steps related to the percentage calculations regarding the interlocal agreement. Council President Campbell requested that a workshop be held prior to the renewing of the next interlocal agreement. Councilmember Alford made a motion to renew the Interlocal Agreement regarding the local option gas tax, which Councilmember Owens seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
