

CRA Budget Workshop

May 27, 2025

The City of Live Oak Community Redevelopment Agency met on Tuesday, May 27, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. in City Hall for a budget workshop. Those present were: Board Chairman Matt Campbell, Board Member Vanessa Robinson, Board Member Gladys Owens, City Clerk John Gill and CRA Attorney Todd Kennon. Absent: Board Member David Alford, Board Member Tommie Jefferson, Board Member Tammy Mobley and Board Member Cindy Robinson.

Chairman Campbell called the meeting to order.

Mayor Frank Davis led the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Chairman Campbell proceeded to discussion regarding the CRA Budget for the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year. CRA Director Nick Frigiola gave an update on the CRA House Bill that was not passed. Mr. Frigiola explained all the money moving forward in 2025, also all the projects that are allocated in 2025.

Mr. Frigiola spoke regarding availability of funds in the amount of \$175,000 for roof repair at Heritage Square & Garden. Mr. Frigiola stated that the Façade Grant still remains the same. Mr. Frigiola also spoke about having camera placed within the CRA district for innovative policing. Also, he spoke about AI technology to help grow and develop property within the city. Mr. Frigiola offered each Board Member to meet with him individually to develop a budget and projects for the upcoming year.
